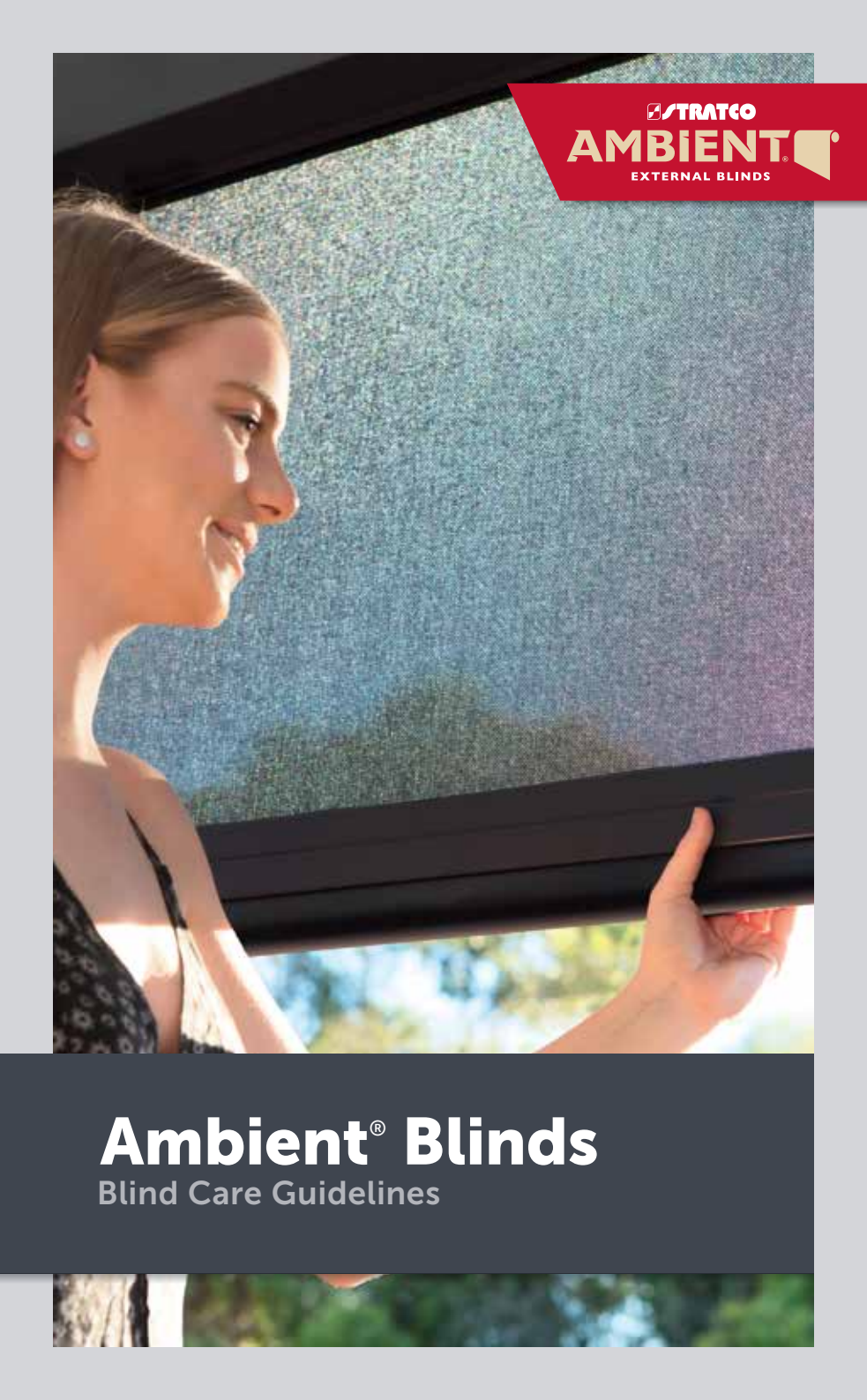

Blind Care Guidelines

Blind Care Guidelines

Prolong the life of your Stratco Ambient® Blind by following our care and maintenance guidelines.

Regularly Clean Your Blind

- Clean your blind at least every 3 months.
- Clean your blind with a soft brush to remove any visible dirt, dust and grime.
- Cleaning regularly with a soft brush along the side channel will help prevent a build-up of dust and dirt.
- Use a soft cloth and warm soapy water to clean the aluminium surfaces. (Do not use abrasive cleaning agents under any circumstances.)
- Operating your blind at least once a week will help to prevent the build-up of dirt and dust that may inhibit the operation of the blind.

Do Not:

- Do not roll up your blind when wet to avoid mould.
- Do not force your blind if it is jamming - contact your Ambient Blinds supplier for assistance.
- Do not leave your blind unrolled during extreme weather conditions or if you are away from home.
- Do not operate your blind by pulling down at the side - always use the handle to pull down from the centre.
- If the blind is fitted with a motor or gearbox for crank operation - do not attempt to manually move the blind, only use the control mechanism.
